On April 15, 2023, on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday, the Sisters took up residence in Fairfield, Connecticut.



Each morning the Sisters celebrate Holy Mass. They sing the Hours of the Divine Office in Latin Gregorian chant through the day, begining at midnight. Time is also given to solitary prayer, *Lectio Divina*, study and the Rosary. On Fridays there is Eucharistic Adoration. They partake of a meatless diet and follow strict observance of enclosure.

The Sisters prayerfully carry out their daily work: cooking, cleaning, sewing, laundry, monastery correspondence and sacristy work. To contribute to their support, they sew Mass linens: corporals, purificators, finger towels, amices and chalice palls; but they rely primarily on alms.
